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

As we begin June, we need to start thinking and start getting ready for the celebration of our 30th anniversary Western Region Clown Association (WRCA) convention being held again this year at the Riverside Hotel & Casino Resort, Laughlin, Nevada – November 8-12, 2015. The fee for this year's convention is \$160 for adults and \$50 for Junior Joeys age 6-17. I want to remind you about our early bird special fee of \$130 – that's a savings of \$30. This special ends (postmarked) September 1, 2015. We also offer \$65 Day Passes for Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday classes and workshops. (Day Passes do not include evening events. Tickets are available.)

Go to our New WRCA website at www.WRCAConvention.org and select "registration." Then fill out the registration form and SAVE with a new name or print it out before closing. You can also register on-line using your credit card by going to "registration" and selecting "register/Pay on line" from the drop-down menu. A handling/convenience fee has been added to some items. This year again you will be able to preorder your buffet tickets at \$8.50 for breakfast or lunch and \$12 for dinner. (No handling/convenience fee for on-line buffet ticket orders.)

This year if you are interested in applying for either of our scholarships, junior joey or family, you can do so on the website by going to "registration" and selecting "scholarships" from the drop-down menu.

NOTE to the staff members, chairs, helpers, etc., your deadline to register is September 1, 2015. Let me know if you did not receive your special registration form. All instructors and vendors registration will be mailed to me, Dennis Owens, c/o WRCA Registration, 8201 Tyrone Ave, Panorama City, CA 91402. Do not mail to Lea or Rick.

So mark your calendar and plan on attending the convention on November 8-12, 2015. That's it for now. Enjoy the rest of 2015 and I hope to see you November 8-12, 2015, in Laughlin.
